Funding Streams

Grants will be awarded to organizations providing projects/activities in the following areas:

- Arts, Culture and Heritage
- Children and Youth
- Community Education
- Environment
- Health and Healthy Living
- Human Services
- Neighbourhood projects
- Sports and Recreation

Guiding Principles

Applications will be evaluated in part based on their ability to demonstrate a commitment to the following principles:

- Innovation
- Impact
- Effectiveness
- Accountability
- Efficient

Ineligible Projects

In general, The Pendle Fund at the Community Foundation of Mississauga will **not** provide funding for the following:

- Deficit reduction
- Fundraising events or campaigns and salaries in support of them
- Political or religious activities
- Individuals
- Sponsorships
- Scholarships or bursaries (excepting those where the scholarship/bursary selection criteria is provided with the grant application, the anticipated learning experience is consistent with the objectives of the Fund and the scholarship/bursary will be awarded in the Fund name as directed by the Foundation)
- On-going operating expenses
- Retroactive funding or for any project expenses to be incurred prior to the Foundation's decision date
- Debt retirement or reserves, mortgage pay-downs
- Programs and services delivered outside of Mississauga

Grant Amounts

The Pendle Fund at the Community Foundation of Mississauga will make grants from \$5,000 to \$30,000.

Application and Deadlines

Organizations can obtain an application for the Pendle Fund at the Community Foundation of Mississauga web site www.CFofM.org. The deadline for all application to be received is March 30, 2012 at 5:00 pm. Applications received after this date will not be considered for this grant cycle.

Submitting an application

It is preferable that you submit your application by email, but if you are submitting a hard copy by regular post, please submit two copies. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
